Outdoor Warning Siren System RESCHEDULED

HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO – Due to the potential for severe weather today, June 5, the Hamilton County Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency (EMHSA) has rescheduled the regular monthly test of the Outdoor Warning Siren System to June 12, 2019 at 12:00pm. EMHSA will not be testing the sirens today, June 5, 2019.

There are three basic criteria to activate the sirens:

- The National Weather Service issues a Tornado Warning for all or part of Hamilton County,
- A tornado is reported by a local public safety official; or
- A dangerous situation occurs which requires citizens to seek shelter immediately.
