OKI Grant Phase Two of Blue Ash Road \$5 million

Ms. Downs reported phase two of Blue Ash Road has moved to the OKI board for approval of \$5,000,000.00. This will go from Duneden to the Silverton corp. line and will include a gateway entrance. The project date timeline is 2025, allowing additional solicitation for grant opportunities to offset the city's match.

Sorta Grant for Oakwood \$1.8 million

Ms. Downs reported that we also received news that SORTA is going to recommend the award of \$1,800,000.00 for improvements to Oakwood Ave. Like OKI, this funding will still funnel through SORTA's committee/board approval process. These funds are going to be available for construction next year at the earliest.

<u> Park Board Committee *Chairman Mark Feldhaus</u>

Mr. Feldhaus announced that the last Party in the Park was a complete success with the final raffle drawing. Boo Fest was this past weekend where we had a great turnout and amazing weather. On November 12 we will have the armchair races in the Community Center. The Christmas tree lighting is scheduled for November 26 from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm and will be in person.

Mayor – Mayor Donnellon noted that good things keep happening in our city and we are moving in the right direction with two grants in the works, paving some streets next year and Plainfield Rd. will get a new water main.
