Mr. Feldhaus announced that in August 2022 there were 793 calls. 1st shift reported 238 details, 2<sup>nd</sup> shift reported 356 details and 3rd shift reported 199 details. The festival went well with no problems. Residents are reminded to lock their vehicles and do not let people that you don't know in your house. The recent threat to Amity School was discussed where Dr. Jetter stated that the juvenile was arrested and charged with domestic terroristic threats. The city remains a safe place to live, work and play.

## Public Works Committee \*Chairman Kathy Downs –

Ms. Downs deferred to Dr. Jetter for this report. Dr. Jetter stated that leaf collection begins on October 17 and goes until almost the end of the year. The roof work on the city building begins soon.
