Safety Committee *Chairman Tom Camp

October 2021 Fire Report

Mr. Camp reported that in the month of October 2021 there were 65 EMS runs and 9 fire runs. There has been a total of 700 runs in the city so far this year and 1907 in the entire district year to date as well. There was a \$315.00 fire loss this month.

October 2021 Police Report

Mr. Feldhaus reported that in the month of October 2021 there were 798 calls for service. 274 on first shift, 387 on second shift and 137 calls on third shift. There have been a rash of car break ins in the tristate area. Some of the offenses are being committed by locals but there is an out of state group of juveniles who are committing the same types of crime. Residents are being reminded to lock their vehicles and do not leave valuables in cars.
