Construction Notice Deer Park Emergent Pole Replacement Project

To Whom It May Concern:

Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., (Duke Energy Ohio or Company) proposes to construct a project known as the Deer Park Emergent Pole Replacement Project (Project). This Project involves the emergency replacement of one 80-foot wooden pole structure with a new 105-foot steel pole due to automobile damage to the pole on the 7481 Circuit in the City of Deer Park, Hamilton County, Ohio. Because of the damage, Duke Energy Ohio proposes to replace the 80-foot wooden pole structure with a new 105-foot steel pole to address the safety concerns stemming from the damaged pole. The proposed new structure will be installed approximately 10-15 feet from the existing structure. The proposed increased height of the new steel pole structure would be in preparation for a future road project. The existing conductor will be moved from the wooden pole to the new steel pole and the height of the lines will not change. The work will be completed in-line with the existing electric transmission line and road right-of-way.

In accordance with O.A.C. 4906-1-01 Appendix A, Duke Energy Ohio is required to prepare this Construction Notice for the Ohio Power Siting Board and, in compliance with O.A.C. 4906-6-07, the Company is hereby providing you with a link to an electronic copy.
