Rumpke Waste Bid & Recycling Bid for years 2018-2023

Mr. Jetter explained that we are looking at recycling every other week instead of our current service of every week with a 5 year lock in rate. The rate to keep weekly recycling service will be \$16.93 per family per year while the rate for every other week recycling service will be \$15.51 per family per year. President Comer stated that we will have another public hearing on this later this month and we welcome community input.

Public Comments –

Mr. Daily was concerned that residents will forget which week is the one that recycling will be collected and will leave their recycling materials at the curb too long if we switch to the every other week service.

Mr. Lehane was concerned that residents might put their recycling in with regular waste so they don't have to wait for their recycling pick up week.
