President Daily opened the meeting at 7:01 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Public Works Committee: Chairman Mike Rapp**

Mr. Rapp announced that potholes are repaired on St. John's Terrace and Plainfield. Mr. Jetter stated that Clifford's potholes are being worked on now.

**Safety Committee: Chairman Tom Camp**

Chief Schlie spoke about fireworks around the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. He has issued orders to road patrols regarding there shall be no possession, use or selling of fireworks. Complaints will have a response although it is not possible to arrest every single person who sets them off. Most responses will elicit a warning and then subsequent complaints can end up with a notice to appear in Mayor's Court and arrest on an M1 fireworks charge. **Legislative and Finance Committee: Chairman Charles Tassell**  
**Resolution for Clifford Road Project(loan application resolution)**

Mr. Jetter spoke regarding amount awarded and stated that the project is to bid. Mr. Tassell motioned to move forward to prepare resolution for Clifford Road project for council's approval. Ms. Newsom seconded the motion. Motion carried by a unanimous voice vote among the legislative and finance committee.

**Ordinance 2019-10**

Mr. Helmes spoke regarding the 3<sup>rd</sup> reading on Ordinance 2019-10 Concealed Carry in the Francis R. Healy building and how it was tabled due to the concern of the community center being close to a school zone. Mr. Helmes and Chief Schlie both did some research and a handout was passed around showing that the community center and the parking lot are both outside the parameter of the 1000 feet rule. Mr. Jetter expressed his opinion on how he is concerned about this passing and allowing just anyone to have their CCW in the community center since we don't have control of who is going in and out of there during events. Discussion ensued.
