Bradley Ruwe with Dinsmore Shohl

Mr. Ruwe spoke to City Council on Tax Increment Financing (TIF) and presented a slideshow and a packet explaining the different types of TIF's. Discussion ensued.

Public Works Committee (Chair Mike Rapp)

Join the Hamilton County Commissioners Seeking Elective Changes

Ms. Culver announced that the Hamilton County Commissioners are asking for legislative bodies/general public in Southwest Ohio to help advocate for better legislation on senior discounts within the Customer Assistance Program for sewer bills.. Ms. Culver would like to have a Resolution passed showing our city's support on this proposal. A packet was given in City Council mailboxes. Discussion ensued.

Clifford Road and St. John's Terrace Projects

Mr. Jetter stated that he has a meeting this week regarding the Clifford Road and St. John's Terrace projects. It costs more money than what the city can afford and we are looking for additional funding. The idea of a bike path from St. John's Terrace through the park and on to Orchard Lane is a work in progress.
