### ***Legislative and Finance Committee***

#### **Presentation Greater Cincinnati Energy Alliance for Get Efficient Home Energy Improvements**

Mr. Jerry Schmits and Mr. Kevin Tolan visited tonight from Greater Cincinnati Energy Alliance. Mr. Tolan presented the information and opportunity for energy savings in the city to council with information packets distributed. Mr. Tassell made a motion to recommend having a resolution drafted.
